

**MINUTES OF THE Extraordinary General Meeting
of LLANGAMMARCH COMMUNITY COUNCIL
Held at 7.30PM ON Thursday February 2nd 2023

Zoom access was opened at 7.20

There were none

2932 Work on the trees on the Riverside Gardens

There was a lot of discussion.

It was finally agreed that the work should be taken in stages.

Stage 1 – Ash No 6, Beech No 10 (both felled) and the white oak No 2 (pollarded).

Stage 3 – the Cherries (3,4,5), plus other trees to be discussed at a later date as the suggestion was that the cherries needed pruning towards the end of summer.

Stage One has two options:

1- Ash, Beech and white oak to be dealt with by company 4 with little or no charge, but a chipper may need to be hired.

2- Ash and Beech dealt with by company 4 and white Oak dealt with by company 3.

Concern was voiced and noted, that company 3 is a tree-surgeon (with a lot of experience) and company 4 is a forester (with a lot of experience).

A vote was taken

Option 1 – 3 votes

Option 2 – 2 votes

There was one abstention

There was, therefore, a majority vote to proceed with Option 1.

The Clerk was instructed to contact company 4.

Cllr Coldrick thanked everyone.

The meeting closed at 8.20pm, as was Zoom access.
